RIFCOM CHARITY CHALLENGE EVENT MAY 2010 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please ensure you read the conditions of entry below before registering for the RifCom Charity Challenge Event (the Event). Your registration implies acceptance of these conditions.

1. To register for the Event we require a registration fee of £350 (non-refundable) which should be enclosed with your application form. If preferable you may pay the registration fee in two equal instalments, one on registration and one on the earlier of one month from registration or 30th March 2010. Your registration fee will be applied towards the cost of your participation in the event. All other funds raised through your sponsorship will go direct to RifCom. Money raised will be donated to RifCom's General Fund.
2. By registering for the Event you are pledging to raise the minimum sponsorship of £450 for RifCom and understand that it is the endeavour of this Event to raise as much above this amount as possible in aid of RifCom.
3. Four weeks before the departure date (29th April 2010) you are required to have sent to RifCom at least 80% of the minimum sponsorship required, with the remainder to be sent on or before the date of departure (27th May 2010).
4. If you cannot raise the minimum sponsorship your place could be forfeit and you should discuss with RifCom how you can realistically make up the balance.
5. Should you have to withdraw, all monies raised should be forwarded to RifCom by way of a donation unless you have previously agreed with your sponsors otherwise.
6. You must be at least 18 years old before the departure date of the event, or accompanied by a parent or guardian if you are aged 16-18.
7. Itineraries, schedules and accommodation may change, and other alterations may occur which are beyond the control of RifCom or any transport companies or tour operators used.
8. RifCom is unable to accept liability for any loss or damage on the event, or for cancellation of the event for any reasons outside their control. Completion of the Registration Form and payment of the Registration Fee implies full acceptance of these Conditions of Entry and the "Declaration, Release of Liability and Assumption of All Risks" detailed on the Registration Form.
9. You will be responsible for providing your own personal equipment, and a kit list will be provided.
10. If for any reason you decide not to take up your place in the Event and would like to nominate someone to take your place, you may do so free of charge at any time up until 3 weeks before departure. After this date any name change could be subject to an administrative charge due to pre-booking transport.
11. RifCom may, at their sole discretion, withdraw places on this Event.
12. RifCom reserves the right to cancel the RifCom Charity Challenge Event May 2010 (the Event) for any reason, but will not cancel the Event less than 30 days before departure except for force majeure, unusual or unforeseen circumstances outside RifCom's control. If the Event is cancelled by RifCom, you may choose between a full refund of all monies raised other than the non-refundable deposit, with these monies to be returned to sponsors or have the monies donated to RifCom. RifCom is not responsible for any incidental expenses that you may have incurred as a result of your booking such as visas, vaccinations, non-refundable travel arrangements separate to the Event or loss of enjoyment, etc.

These Conditions of Entry are governed by the Laws of Gibraltar and the exclusive jurisdiction of Gibraltar Courts.
